Exhibitors are asked to be setup by 8:30 a.m. Setup time is between 7a.m.-8:30 a.m. on the day of the event. We provide a 10 X 10 foot space with a 6 foot table with table cloth, 1 sign, and 2 chairs. Exhibitors are encouraged to have a child/family friendly activity at their booth.



Terms and Conditions

General Restrictions

- Exhibitors are prohibited from using amplifying equipment that is objectionable to MACC (e.g. microphones, speakers, and megaphones).
- Exhibitors must confine their activities to their assigned space.
- Exhibitors will ensure that its agents, servants, employees, and contractors attending the event have not been convicted of felony sex offences.
- Exhibitors will not be permitted to use strolling entertainment or to distribute samples or souvenirs except from their own booths.
- Exhibitors who use costumed models or mannequins should be sure that their manner of appearance and dress is such as not to offend even the most critical.
- Draping materials and other decorative materials must be flameproof and comply with all State and local regulations.
- MACC reserves the right to require the modification of any questionable exhibit.
- "Cash and Carry" sales are not permitted at the community fair.
- Exhibitors must comply with all safety provisions as required by MACC and City of Dallas codes, including those pertaining to food service and obtain any permits, if necessary.
- The laws of the State of Texas shall govern the construction, interpretation and enforcement of this agreement.

Liabilities

The Exhibitor agrees that the Marsalis Avenue Church of Christ (MACC), its agents, members, and employees: (a) Will not be responsible for any damage to, loss, or destruction of the Exhibitor's property or injuries to the Exhibitor, his representatives, agents or employees, all claims for any such loss, damage, destruction, or injury being expressly waived by the Exhibitor, (b) Will be exempted from or indemnified for any claims for injury to any of the Exhibitor's representatives, agents, or employees (c) will be exempted from or indemnified for any claims of violation or infringement (or claim of violation or infringement) of any law or ordinance or the rights of any party under any patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary right; (d) any libel, slander, defamation or similar claims resulting from the actions of exhibitor. The Exhibitor may be required to provide a certificate of insurance to MACC. Exhibitor shall also indemnify and save and hold harmless MACC from and against any cost, expense, liability, or damage which may be incident to, arise out of, or be caused by an act, omission, negligence or misconduct on the part of Exhibitor or its agents, servants, employees, contractors, guests, licensees or invitees, provided such damage or injury has not occurred due to the gross negligence of MACC. MACC, its agents, members, and employees will not be liable for failure to hold the Exhibits as scheduled because of fire, or any act of God, or epidemic, or act of terrorism or any law or regulation of public authority or any other act beyond the control of MACC, which makes it impossible or impracticable to hold the Exhibition.
