### Using Your Preschool Make-n-Share

*Preschool Make-n-Share* contains 13 preschool projects and 1 Scamper the puppet activity. Also included are two pages of peel-and-press stickers and two bonus coloring pages.

Suggestions are included in your *Preschool Teacher Guide* for using each craft activity. Each activity is designed so that the child has something to hold and manipulate while sharing a truth learned in the day's Bible lesson.

### **Preparing the projects**

- Separate the craft pages by tearing them apart along the perforation. For most preschoolers you will need to cut out the activities. Leave some simple cutting for advanced preschoolers to encourage the development of their scissor skills.
- Cut off the portion of the sticker pages needed for each lesson.
- Make a sample of each craft.
- Store the sample and materials for each lesson in a labeled envelope or file folder so nothing is lost.

Remember to enlist volunteers to help with this preparation.

### **Gathering supplies**

In planning ahead for the quarter, you will need to gather both general supplies and some specific supplies needed for completing the projects.

### **General supplies**

- crayons
- pencils
- washable markers
- blunt-tip scissors
- tape
- glue sticks
- hole punch
- resealable plastic bags

### Extra supplies this quarter

You will need for each child:

- Lesson 1-two 12" lengths of yarn
- Lesson 2—craft stick
- Lesson 8—brown paper lunch bag
- Lesson 9—adhesive-backed magnet
- Lesson 13—paper fastener

Display your sample craft and let the children enjoy fun, involved Bible learning!


### **Terrific Trumpet**
